



2022-2023 LYO CONCERTO COMPETITION RULES

(See PAGE 2 for the application)

1. Eligibility:
 - a. The Concerto Competition is limited to Symphony and Repertory Orchestra members only.
 - b. Applicants must be a junior or senior during the 2022-2023 season.
 - c. Applicants must have been a member of the LYO for at least one year prior to auditioning.
 - d. Winners of previous concerto competitions may not audition again with the same orchestra.
 - e. Each participant must be a member in good standing (all fees paid) of the LYO.
2. Selections must be pre-approved by Doug Elmore or Ian Elmore. Students must audition on the composition they intend to perform with the orchestra.
3. The length of the piece/movement must be 15 minutes or less. You are expected to perform the entire movement or solo on which you are auditioning. Memorization is encouraged, but not required of participants.
4. The composition must be for solo instrument and orchestra. Duets will be accepted at the discretion of the Concerto Competition Committee. The composition must have orchestral parts readily available from the publisher.
5. You must have an accompanist for your audition and it is your responsibility to secure an accompanist. (Pianists are exempt from this rule.) If you need help finding one, email abrody@lyo.org as early as possible for suggestions, but the LYO cannot guarantee their availability. Please pay your accompanist fairly and make an agreement with them up front.
6. The accompanist and soloist should arrive at least 20 minutes prior to the audition time. Warm-up rooms/areas will be provided. You will be emailed your warm-up and competition time by October 4.
7. On the day of the audition, the soloist must meet performance standards, regardless of length or difficulty of the composition.
8. On the day of the audition, judges must be provided with **THREE (3) COPIES** of the music to be performed. It is not necessary to have originals.

The winner will perform the concerto at the March 19, 2023 LYO concert.

Please note that cancellations should be made no later than 48 hours prior to the competition by emailing abrody@lyo.org or calling the LYO office at 502-896-1851.
